

Suggested Material List – Grade 10, 11, 12

Students should bring the following supplies to class:

- one binder per subject
- binder dividers
- loose-leaf
- graph paper
- pens (red, blue, black)
- ruler (30 cm / 12 " transparent)
- pencils
- package of Hilroy scribblers
- page reinforcers
- highlighters
